DECORATIONS

Poinsettia plants, Holly and Mistletoe are poisonous to cats and dogs. Be sure to keep kept them out of your pet's reach. Do not use tinsel if you have cats as they are very attracted to it. It can get stuck in their intestines, and they may require surgery.

GIFT WRAP

When gift wrapping, be sure to keep your pet away. Wrapping paper, string, plastic and cloth can also cause intestinal blockages and death. Be careful of bows on packages under your tree. Our kitty ate a metallic elastic bow and would have died without immediate surgery.

FOOD

Chocolate is very toxic to pets, and onions can cause anemia. Grapes and raisins cause kidney failure in dogs. Macadamia nuts are also very toxic. Make sure there are no turkey, ham or chicken bones left around that your pets can find. If ingested, they can splinter and get stuck in the throat causing choking and death or very serious damage to a pet's mouth, throat, and intestines. Cooked bones of any kind are strictly forbidden.

Contact your vet immediately if your pet has ingested any of the above.

History of The Levee

The first recorded levee in Canada was held on January 1, 1646, in the Chateau St. Louis by **Charles Huault de Montmagny**, Governor of New France from 1636 to 1648.

In addition to wishing a happy new year to the citizens the governor informed guests of significant events in France as well as the state of affairs within the colony.

In turn, the settlers were expected to renew their pledges of allegiance to the Crown. The levee tradition was continued by British colonial governors in Canada and subsequently by both the governor general and lieutenant governors.

Today the levée has evolved from the earlier, more boisterous party of years past into a more sedate and informal one. It is an occasion to call upon representatives of the monarch, military and municipal governments and to exchange New Year's greetings and best wishes for the new year, to renew old acquaintances and to meet new friends. It is also an opportunity to reflect upon the events of the past year and to welcome the opportunities of the New Year.
